COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS MAY APPLY:⁵

Mechanical breakdowns covered by the vehicle's manufacturer's warranty. Mechanical breakdowns caused by collision, vandalism, or weather-related conditions. Mechanical breakdowns caused by lack of maintenance or preexisting conditions. Vehicles used for competitive racing or for a prohibited commercial purpose, such as rideshare services.

Agreement terms are measured from the Agreement purchase date and odometer reading at the time of purchase. ² Platinum exclusionary coverage includes all mechanical parts of the vehicle in the event of a mechanical breakdown unless they are specifically listed as not covered in the Agreement. ³ Any necessary replacement parts will be replaced at the program administrator's discretion using new, remanufactured, or like-kind and quality parts. ⁴ Towing reimbursement is eligible up to \$100 per incident if required due to a covered mechanical breakdown. ⁵ Additional exclusions may apply.
